- We have widespread testing (RT-PCR) ability for all staff and patients.
- We have a daily symptom screening policy for all staff.
- We have altered all necessary environments to maintain social distancing.
- We have non-COVID care units.

- We have developed a non-COVID care pathway for all elective procedures. From parking, pre-surgical testing to discharge – You will not cross paths with any COVID+ patients or staff caring for COVID+ patients.
- We have capacity in all units and maintain a surge plan should there be a resurgence of COVID.
